FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF METUCHEN ALL-CHURCH NOMINATING COMMITTEE

The All-Church Nominating Committee is in the process of developing a slate of church officers who will serve for the next three years or one year term. The Committee needs your help in identifying potential leaders in our church to serve as Elders (3-year term), Deacons (3-year term) and as members of our All Church Nominating Committee (1-year term) and Audit Committee (1-year term).

Please give prayerful consideration to those people who you know are active and involved in our church community and who would be strong leaders for us in the future. Additionally, review the responsibilities below and consider where you have the time, talents and willingness to serve our congregation yourself in this important way.

The All-Church Nominating Committee will consider all recommendations as it develops a slate of candidates for each board. Please submit your "Recommendation" forms by March 11th so that your suggestions and comments will assist us in our process.

Remember that your recommendations are not nominations and you do not have to ask a person's permission before submitting their name. The Committee is interested in knowing who you believe would be the best leaders and particularly if you are interested in serving on a board.

To help you in your considerations and making recommendations, following are the responsibilities and duties of the different boards:

ELDERS/TRUSTEES

"Together with the Ministers of the Word of Sacrament, Elders/Trustees exercise leadership, government, and discipline and have responsibilities for the life of a particular church as well as the church at large, including ecumenical relationships. (from the Book of Order, G-2.0301) Our governing Unicameral Board is also called the "Session".

In our church, the responsibilities include:

- Active leadership through faithful attendance at worship and participation in church programs and activities.
- Attend monthly stated meetings.
- Serve on, and possibly chair, a church commission or committee. (Meet once a month)
- Assist in serving the Sacrament of Communion to the congregation.
- Formally receive new members into the congregation at special called meetings.
- Support, participate in and assist with church stewardship programs.

DEACONS

"Persons of spiritual character, honest repute, of exemplary lives, brotherly and sisterly love, sincere compassion, and sound judgment should be chosen for this office." (from the Book of Order, G-2-0201) The Deacons ministry is one of compassion, witness and service.

In our church, the responsibilities include:

- Active leadership through faithful attendance at worship and participation in church programs and activities
- Attend monthly stated meetings.
- Assist in serving the Sacrament of Communion to the congregation.
- Participate on a team that involves a different activity once a month flower delivery, visitation partner, and visitation at Whispering Knoll Assisted Living in Edison. Each requiring approximately 1 to 2 hours of time per month.
- Support, participate in and assist with church stewardship programs.

COMMISSION/COMMITTEE

A Commission is a body provided for by the Session, or Unicameral Board, of the Church to oversee a particular part of the Church's life and ministry. Each Commission has the authority to carry out the goals established by the Unicameral Board, and regularly reports its decision and actions to that Board

A Committee carries out specific tasks and reports to a Commission. In our church, the responsibilities include:

- Attend monthly stated meetings.
- Identify needs and opportunities for Church action
- Discuss, deliberate and decide on actions to be taken (to meet the needs and/or seize the opportunities) for ministry
- Communicate, confer and coordinate with other interested areas of Church ministry before a final decision is made or action taken
- Initiate action by assigning specific responsibilities, setting time limits, and monitoring task to completion.

On-going interpretation, implementation, and development of our stewardship program

Worship, Arts & Community Life Commission

Indonesian Fellowship, Sanctuary & Sacraments, Music and Arts, Ushers and Greeters.

Youth Fellowship, Mission Trip, 30-Hour Famine, and Young Adults
